

Attention Vendors!

Please arrive after 8 am and unload your tent, merchandise and gear.

Move your vehicle to remote parking away from Third and Main Streets.

Come back and set up. The streets will be closed to vehicular traffic by 10:30, so if you don't want to lug your stuff to your slot, come early.

The Festival starts at 11 am. There will be food, coffee, beverages available from street vendors or local restaurants along the site. The Town of Palisade maintains permanent Public Rest Rooms on the North East end of Main Street adjacent to the Plaza.

Remember this is Colorado--the weather forecast may change several times before Saturday. In fact, it may change at any time during the day as well. Be prepared.

You will need a pop up tent (8 x 8 or 10 x 10) that you can anchor securely. If you have sides that attach, bring them too. You will need tables, folding chairs, warm jacket, comfortable clothing, rain gear, sun glasses, snacks and water and other creature comforts to make your day more enjoyable. Food Vendors are self contained with their vehicles and can only park in the designated areas assigned.

Please refer to maps before you set out. Palisade is accessible off I-70 via Exit 42, south on Elberta to First Street. Take a left and go East on First to Main Street. Take a right for two blocks until you reach the Plaza. Refer to the site map before hand to locate your site.

There will be additional site maps, schedules, and other bee related materials at the Information Tent in the Plaza.

Clean up is at 4 pm, so please be mindful that you are responsible for leaving your site as clean as you found it. Large trash cans will be placed in several places along both streets. Pitch in!

Bring your positive attitude and bee prepared to have a good time!
